<sup>2</sup>While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

<sup>3</sup>Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off. **ACTS 13:2,3**

Acts 13 marks the first missionary journey of Paul. As the congregation worshiped God and fasted, they heard the Holy Spirit's specific instructions for Barnabas and Saul to go to the nations. They responded in faith and obedience. In the same way, the church continues to send missionaries to fulfill the Great Commission. Though not everyone can go, everyone can—and should—participate in this call. In this lesson, we will look at how we can bring the gospel to every nation.
